What is the fellowship?

The Fellowship for Teachers is a **eight-month** cohort-based **professional development opportunity** for secondary school educators.

Teachers explore religious difference in the classroom by attending to four key areas: curriculum, students' lived experiences, school context, and teachers' perspectives.

- Assistance in creating a project
- Stipend

Fellow Commitments

- Attend monthly meetings
- Prepare, present, and share one original project (lesson plan, presentation, etc.) for your school
- Explore additional learning opportunities to build religious literacy
- Write one reflection essay
